NOTE -- THE GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT (GNP) FIXED WEIGHT CHAIN INDEX REFLECTS INFLATION THROUGHOUT THE ECONOMY, AND THE CPI FOR ALL ITEMS MEASURES THE IMPACT OF INFLATION ON CONSUMERS. THE CPI INDEX OF ALL TELEPHONE SERVICES IS BASED ON A "MARKET BASKET" INTENDED TO REPRESENT THE TELEPHONE RELATED EXPENDITURES OF A TYPICAL URBAN HOUSEHOLD. IT INCLUDES BOTH LOCAL AND LONG DISTANCE SERVICES. THE CPI INDEX OF LOCAL TELEPHONE CHARGES IS BASED ON MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGES, MESSAGE UNIT CHARGES, LEASED EQUIPMENT, INSTALLATION, ENHANCED SERVICES (SUCH AS TONE DIALING AND CALL WAITING), TAXES, SUBSCRIBER LINE CHARGES, AND ALL OTHER CONSUMER EXPENDITURES ASSOCIATED WITH TELEPHONE SERVICES EXCEPT LONG DISTANCE CHARGES. IN CONTRAST, THE PPI INDEX OF LOCAL RESIDENTIAL SERVICES IS BASED ONLY ON SERVICE CHARGES FOR RESIDENTIAL SERVICE, OPTIONAL TOUCH-TONE SERVICE, AND SUBSCRIBER LINE CHARGES.

* IN 1992 THE BUREAU OF ECONOMIC ANALYSIS (BEA) REVISED THE METHODOLOGY FOR CALCULATING THE GDP FIXED WEIGHT PRICE INDEXES. THE BEA REVISED THE INDEX FOR 1982 THROUGH THE PRESENT. THE TABLE SHOWS PERCENTAGE CHANGES FOR THE GNP UNREVISED SERIES FOR 1978 THROUGH 1982.
