Mr. O'NEILL, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution;
which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
3 the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the
4 Union for the consideration of the bill (S. 1898) to amend
5 the Communications Act of 1934 with respect to the pro-
6 cedure in obtaining a license and for rehearings under such
7 Act. After general debate, which shall be confined to the
8 bill, and shall continue not to exceed three hours, to be
9 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking
10 minority member of the Committee on Interstate and Foreign
11 Commerce, the bill shall be read for amendment under the
12 five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider without

1 the intervention of any point of order the amendment in the
2 nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
3 Interstate and Foreign Commerce now in the bill, and such
4 amendment, for the purpose of amendment, shall be con-
5 sidered under the five-minute rule as an original bill. At the
6 conclusion of the consideration of the bill for amendment,
7 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
8 with such amendments as may have been adopted, and the
9 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
10 and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
11 motion except one motion to recommit with or without
12 instructions.
