AMENDMENTS

Intended to be proposed by Mr. PACKWOOD to the amendment (numbered 308) proposed by Mr. PASTORE (for himself and others) to S. 382, a bill to promote fair practices in the conduct of election campaigns for Federal political offices, and for other purposes, viz:

1 On page 27, line 21, strike "SEC. 305." and insert in
2 lieu thereof "SEC. 305. (a)".

3 On page 28, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:

4 “(b) Any person who in any calendar year makes
5 available any property (including money), facilities, or
6 services of a value of \$500 or more to or for the benefit of
7 a program operated by another person for the purpose of
8 educating or registering voters or supporting a ‘get-out-the-
9 vote’ campaign shall report, on the first reporting date under
10 section 304 (a) which occurs after such transfer, the amount

1 or value of such transfer, the name and address of the person
2 to whom such property was transferred, the location and a
3 description of such program, and the name and address of
4 the person making such transfer. Reports under this sub-
5 section shall be filed with the Comptroller General, and shall
6 include such additional information, as he may prescribe by
7 regulation.”
