Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC requests special temporary authority to continue to operate its Galaxy 15 space station as an in-orbit spare at the 133.1 W.L. orbital location for a period of 180 days. Intelsat seeks continued authority to conduct telemetry, tracking, and telecommand operations using frequencies centered on 6420.5 MHz (Earth-to-space) and 4198.0 MHz and 4199.875 MHz (space-to-Earth) to maintain the Galaxy 15 space station at 133.1° W.L. In addition, Intelsat seeks authority to activate the communications payloads for the Galaxy 15 space station in the 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 5925-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands in the event of a service outage of an operational space station.
