NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: April 19, 2012

By the District Director, Tampa Office, South Central Region, and Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation (Notice) issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's rules¹ to Comcast Cable Communications (Comcast), operator of a cable system in Fort Pierce, Florida.
2. On February 17, 2012, agents of the Enforcement Bureau's Tampa Office inspected the Comcast Cable Communications system located in Fort Pierce, Florida, and observed the following violation(s):
 - a. 47 C.F.R. § 76.605(a) (12): "As an exception to the general provision requiring measurements to be made at subscriber terminals, and without regard to the type of signals carried by the cable television system, signal leakage from a cable television system shall be measured in accordance with the procedures outlined in § 76.609(h) and shall be limited as follows: Over 54 MHz up to and including 216 MHz – 20 micro-volts per meter, measured at 3 meters." At the time of the inspection, agents observed the indicated signal leakage, on the frequency of 121.2625 MHz, at the following locations:
 - 1) 4203 Matanzas Avenue ----- 397.64 μV/m
 - 2) Pole at 4804 Juanita Avenue----- 28.40 μV/m
3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Sections 1.16 and 1.89 of the Commission's rules,³ Comcast Cable Communications, must submit a written statement concerning this matter within twenty (20) days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and

should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the cable operator. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

4. This Notice shall be sent to Comcast Cable Communications at its address of record.
5. The Privacy Act of 1974⁴ requires that we advise you that the Commission will use all relevant material information before it, including any information disclosed in your reply, to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure compliance. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁵
