**NOTICE OF UNLICENSED OPERATION**

The New York Office received information that a private land mobile station allegedly was operating on frequency 452.0 MHz from 20 Demeter Road in Belvidere, New Jersey without a license and was interfering with a private land mobile station licensed to operate on 452.0 MHz in Belvidere. On April 30, 2012, and May 1, 2012, an agent from this office confirmed that radio signals on frequency 452.0 MHz were emanating from 20 Demeter Road location. The agent also confirmed that the signals emanating from that location were controlled by a base station operated by County Concrete Corporation in Oxford, New Jersey. The Commission's records show that no license was issued for operation of a station at 20 Demeter Road on the frequency 452.0 MHz in Belvidere, New Jersey.

Radio stations must be licensed by the FCC pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 301. You are hereby warned that operation of radio transmitting equipment without a valid radio station authorization constitutes a violation of the Federal laws cited above and could subject the operator to severe penalties, including, but not limited to, substantial monetary fines, *in rem* arrest action against the offending radio equipment, and criminal sanctions including imprisonment. (*see* 47 U.S.C. §§ 401, 501, 503 and 510).

**UNLICENSED OPERATION OF THIS RADIO STATION MUST BE DISCONTINUED IMMEDIATELY.**

You have ten (10) days from the date of this notice to respond with any evidence that you have authority to operate granted by the FCC. Your response should be sent to the address in the letterhead and reference the listed case and document number. Under the Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. § 552a(e)(3), we are informing you that the Commission's staff will use all relevant material information before it to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure your compliance with FCC Rules. This will include any information that you disclose in your reply.
