ORDER

By the Senior Deputy Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau:

1. AT&T Mobility Spectrum LLC (“AT&T Mobility”), an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of AT&T Inc. (collectively, “AT&T”), and Cox TMI Wireless, LLC (“Cox”) filed an application (“Application”) pursuant to section 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ seeking to assign eight Lower 700 MHz Band B Block licenses from Cox to AT&T Mobility. This application was placed on an accepted for filing public notice on May 15, 2012, with a petition to deny due date of May 29, 2012.²

2. Public Knowledge filed a motion for extension of time to file petitions to deny with respect to the Application on May 22, 2012, seeking an additional two weeks in which to file a petition to deny.³ Public Knowledge asserts that there are now pending multiple transfer proceedings, many involving Cox, and that any analysis of the impact of the above-referenced application on the competitive and spectrum landscape will be very complex.⁴ Public Knowledge also points out that the current petition to deny due date follows a three-day holiday weekend, further shortening the time for analysis and preparing a filing.⁵ Finally, Public Knowledge represents that AT&T and Cox have stated that they do not oppose grant of the requested extension of time.

3. In light of the showing made by Public Knowledge and its representation that AT&T and Cox do not object to grant of the Motion, we will grant the requested extension of time. We find that providing an additional two weeks for analysis by interested parties and the submission of petitions to deny will help to provide us with a more complete record in connection with our review of the Application.

4. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to sections 4(i) and 309(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 309(d), the Motion for Extension of Time To File Petitions To Deny filed by Public Knowledge in this proceeding IS GRANTED.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to sections 4(i), 309(d), and 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 309(d), 310(d), and section 1.948 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.948, the revised pleading cycle is as follows:

Petitions to Deny Due:	June 12, 2012
Oppositions Due:	June 22, 2012
Replies Due:	June 29, 2012
