
Dear Chairman Genachowski:

I am writing to you to request an update on the status of the two Applications for Review filed by Clarity Media Systems LLC (Clarity) and KlaasKids Foundation (Klaas) regarding Clarity's application to establish a multichannel video service for professional long-haul truck drivers (FCC DA 07-1946). In addition to offering television service to truck drivers, Clarity's service would also provide truck drivers with valuable information about national and local emergencies, including information about missing children and possible threats to our nation's homeland security.

As you know, Clarity originally filed its proposal in 2005, and it was denied in May 2007. Clarity and Klaas subsequently filed Applications for Review in June 2007. It is our understanding that Clarity and Klaas' applications have been reviewed by FCC staff and are pending consideration by the Commission.

It has now been more than four years since Clarity and Klaas filed their Applications for Review. While I have no position on these applications, I do feel that FCC should promptly consider and reach an official decision on this matter. We appreciate your attention to this issue.
