Modification

SES Americom, Inc. requests modification of its authorization for the AMC-2 space station in order to specify operations at the 19.0° E.L. orbital location, rather than its currently licensed location of 4.98° E.L. SES seeks authority to provide Fixed-Satellite Service, including direct-to-home service, in the 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. SES also seeks authority to use the following center frequencies for telemetry, tracking and control: 6423.5 MHz (Earth-to-space); 3700.5 MHz, 4100.5 MHz, and 12198.0 MHz (space-to-Earth). SES requests waivers of Sections 25.114(d)(3), 25.202(g), and 25.210(j) of the Commission's rules in connection with its request.
