NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: July 11, 2012

By the Resident Agent, Miami Office, South Central Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation (Notice) issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's rules,¹ to Qualicom Systems, Inc. (Qualicom), registrant of antenna structure number 1012981 in Immokalee, Florida.

2. On June 28, 2012, an agent of the Enforcement Bureau's Miami Office inspected the site for antenna structure number 1012981 located in Immokalee, Florida, and observed the following violation:

47 C.F.R. § 17.57: "The owner of an antenna structure for which an Antenna Structure Registration Number has been obtained must notify the Commission within 24 hours of completion of construction (FCC Form 854-R) and/or dismantlement (FCC Form 854). The owner must also immediately notify the Commission using FCC Form 854 upon any change in structure height or change in ownership information." At the time of inspection, an agent observed that no structure was present at the site for antenna structure number 1012981. However, the Commission's Antenna Structure Registration database shows the status of antenna structure number 1012981 as "constructed."

3. Pursuant to Section 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's rules, Qualicom must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of Qualicom. All replies and documentation sent in response to

4. This Notice shall be sent to by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, and First Class Mail to Qualicom at its address of record.

5. The Privacy Act of 1974³ requires that we advise you that the Commission will use all relevant material information before it, including any information disclosed in your reply, to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure compliance. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
