ON TODAY'S REPORT FROM THE
PRESIDENT'S COUNCIL OF ADVISORS ON SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Washington, D.C.—In response to the release of the President's Council of Advisors on Science and Technology (PCAST) Spectrum Report:
