ORDER

Following the filing of the Document Requests for Production of Documents, and the subsequent Objections and Responses thereto, by Game Show Network, LLC and Cablevision Systems Corp. (“the non-governmental parties”) in this case, each non-governmental party had the opportunity to file a motion to compel production of documents to the extent that those requests were not complied with, in accordance with 47 CFR 1.325(a)(2). The proper period for filing those motions has passed and no such motions have been made before the Presiding Judge. As both non-governmental parties raised numerous grounds for objections to the document requests made of them, the Presiding Judge finds it helpful to receive updates from these parties to ensure that document production is proceeding smoothly.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the non-governmental parties shall submit a Joint Status Report on or before **August 20, 2012** on (1) the progress of document production as described in the document requests, and subsequent objections and responses, previously served by each party and (2) the existence of any obstacles or refusals to document production that a submitting party confronts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that discovery must be a cooperative effort in order to stay the course in this “expedited” proceeding.
