NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: September 27, 2012

By the District Director, Denver District Office, Western Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation (Notice) issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules,¹ to Kohler Communications of Williston, Inc. (KCWI), registrant of antenna structure # 1205079 by Williston, ND. Pursuant to Section 1.89(a) of the Commission's Rules, issuance of this NOV does not preclude the Enforcement Bureau from further action if warranted, including issuing a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture for the violation(s) noted herein.²

2. On August 6, 2012, an agent of the Enforcement Bureau's Denver District Office inspected antenna structure # 1205079 located on Highway 1804, approximately five miles east of Williston, ND, and observed the following violations:

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 17.21: "Antenna structures shall be painted and lighted when:
(a) they exceed 60.96 meters (200 feet) in height above the ground or they require special aeronautical study." The FCC Antenna Structure Registration (ASR) for antenna structure # 1205079 requires that it be lit in accordance with FCC Paragraphs 1, 3, 11, and 21. Paragraph 1 requires that the tower be painted and Paragraph 11 requires two red lights at the mid-level height of the tower. At the time of the August 6, 2012, inspection the agent observed that one of the two mid-level lights was extinguished.

- b. 47 C.F.R. § 17.50: "Antenna structures requiring painting under this part shall be cleaned or repainted as often as necessary to maintain good visibility." During the inspection on August 6, 2012, the agent observed that the paint was very faded and chipped.

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3. Pursuant to Section 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,³ and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, we seek additional information concerning the violations and any remedial actions taken. Therefore, KCWI must submit a written statement concerning this matter within twenty (20) days of release of this Notice. The response (i) must fully explain each violation, including all relevant surrounding facts and circumstances, (ii) must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and (iii) must include a time line for completion of any pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and must not be abbreviated by reference to other communications or answers to other notices.⁴

4. In accordance with Section 1.16 of the Commission's Rules, we direct KCWI to support its response to this Notice with an affidavit or declaration under penalty of perjury, signed and dated by an authorized officer of KCWI with personal knowledge of the representations provided in KCWI's response, verifying the truth and accuracy of the information therein,⁵ and confirming that all of the information requested by this Notice which is in the licensee's possession, custody, control, or knowledge has been produced. To knowingly and willfully make any false statement or conceal any material fact in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁶
