**ORDER**

On October 24, 2012, the Presiding Judge issued *Order* FCC 12M-48, directing the Enforcement Bureau (“Bureau”), Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC (“Maritime”), Warren Havens, and the SkyTel entities to file Status Reports regarding 93 boxes of documents that SkyTel-O speculated in its Opposition to Motion for Partial Summary Judgment may raise material issue(s) of fact preventing summary decision. The *Order* required the parties to file their Status Reports by November 1, 2012. The Bureau indicated by e-mail that a November 1 deadline will be difficult to meet, as both the Bureau and Maritime are preparing for imminent depositions. The Bureau requests an extension of deadlines to November 8, 2012, and Maritime supports this request.

Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to extend the Status Report deadline in order to ensure that each party has opportunity to present fully its understanding of the contents of these “93 boxes” and state whether, based on first-hand knowledge, some of the “box documents” probably raise material issues of relevant fact. Mere speculation will not suffice.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, IT IS ORDERED that the latest time for submitting Status Reports IS EXTENDED to 5:30 PM EST on November 8, 2012.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties file electronically and serve courtesy copies, which shall include appropriate confirmation of electronic filing, by e-mail.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Status Report should be filed jointly by two or more parties, if feasible and practicable.
