
A Prehearing Conference was held on November 20, 2012, at the request of the Enforcement Bureau (EB). The agenda of subjects for discussions was set forth in *Order FCC 12M-50*.

The following schedule was established at the conference on-the-record:

- November 28, 2012** - Counsel for Pinnacle to submit to Presiding Judge proposed language for consideration that has been copied to counsel for the parties, modifying the case Protective Order in order to protect against indirect discovery of competitively sensitive business documents through FOIA.
- November 28, 2012** - EB and Maritime to submit *an unqualified* Stipulation wherein the parties agree upon the status of Maritime's winding up of its provision of AMTS to end user subscribers on and after December 31, 2007.
- November 28, 2012** - EB and Maritime to submit partially revised discovery schedule to accommodate delays caused by Hurricane Sandy in order to permit EB to complete its deposition discovery of the DePriests, as well as supplement prior depositions by selective interrogatories, document requests, and requests to admit.
- December 5, 2012** - James Chen, new counsel for Mr. Havens and SkyTel companies, will submit authorities relied on by Mr. Havens for his proposed definition of term "constructed" that may or may not be included in a proposed Glossary.
- December 5, 2012** - EB, Maritime, SkyTel, and Mr. Havens to jointly submit a current draft of the Glossary, specifying whether each term and definition is mutually agreed upon, contested but possibly resolvable, or contested and unresolvable.
