**ORDER**

*Order* FCC 12M-53 requires the Enforcement Bureau, Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC, SkyTel, and Mr. Havens to jointly submit a draft glossary to the Presiding Judge on December 5, 2012, which is today. By e-mail this afternoon, the Enforcement Bureau indicated that a disagreement exists between itself and Mr. Havens as to the time at which the draft glossary must be filed.<sup>1</sup> In order to resolve this disagreement and obtain guidance on how

to proceed in finalizing the draft glossary, the Enforcement Bureau has felt it necessary to request a telephone conference with the Presiding Judge.

At this late hour, a telephone conference would not only be burdensome to all concerned, but also unnecessary. A brief filing extension with an explicitly set deadline resolves the disagreement cleanly, while providing the concerned parties with sufficient time to finalize their submission.

Accordingly, the Enforcement Bureau's request for a telephone conference IS DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the filing deadline for the Joint Draft Glossary IS EXTENDED to **December 6, 2012 at High Noon — 12:00 pm EST.**<sup>2</sup>
