ORDER

On December 10, 2012, Choctaw Communications, LLC and Choctaw Holdings, LLC (together "Choctaw") filed a Petition to Intervene in this proceeding. Choctaw argues that it meets the criteria for intervention because the disposition of the issues in this proceeding will have a direct effect on the ability of Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC (Maritime), per the agreement approved by the Northern District of Mississippi Bankruptcy Court, to

prosecute the applications that are required for the assignment of the spectrum licenses it holds to Choctaw. Petition at 1-2. Choctaw also argues that its Petition is appropriately timed, as it was filed within 30 days of the approval of the agreement by the Bankruptcy Court on November 15, 2012, which created its interest in this proceeding. *Id.* Choctaw's Petition is unopposed.

For good cause shown, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene of Choctaw Communications, LLC and Choctaw Holdings, LLC IS GRANTED.
