Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC requests special temporary authority for a period of 180 days, to conduct telemetry, tracking, and command functions necessary to drift the Galaxy 11 space station from its currently authorized orbital location of 55.5° W.L. to the 55.6° W.L. orbital location, and to maintain Galaxy 11 upon its arrival at 55.6° W.L., using the following center frequencies: 11.701 GHz and 11.702 GHz (space to Earth); and 14.0005 GHz and 14.4985 GHz (Earth to space). Intelsat also requests special temporary authority to provide Fixed-Satellite Service via Galaxy 11 during the drift to and upon arrival at the 55.6° W.L. orbital location in the 10.95-11.20 GHz (space-to-Earth), 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth), and 13.75-14.50 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands.
