Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC requests special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to conduct telemetry, tracking, and command functions necessary to drift the Intelsat 701 space station from its currently authorized orbital location of 157.0° E.L. to the 29.5° W.L. orbital location using the following center frequencies: 6173.7 MHz and 6176.3 MHz (Earth-to-space); 3947.5 MHz, 3948.0 MHz, 3952.5 MHz, and 3952.0 MHz (space-to-Earth).
