Modification

On February 27, 2013, EchoStar Satellite Operating Corporation filed an application requesting modification of its authorization to operate the EchoStar 6 space station. The application seeks authority to operate the space station at the 96.2° W.L. orbital location using the 12.2-12.7 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 17.3-17.8 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands to provide satellite service outside the United States. The application is accepted for filing for purposes of considering authorization of fixed satellite and mobile satellite services, operating on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis.
