EchoStar Satellite Operating Corporation seeks to modify its authorization for the EchoStar 3 space station to specify operations in the 12.2-12.7 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 17.3-17.8 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands at the 86.4° W.L. orbital location, rather than its currently assigned orbital location of 61.8° W.L. Telemetry, tracking, and command operations for EchoStar 3 will be provided using the following center frequencies: 12.201 GHz, 12.203 GHz, and 12.699 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 17.3015 GHz (Earth-to-space).
