Re: Municipality of Florida Petition for Reconsideration of Dismissal of File No. 0003463003 and Request for Late-Filed Renewal and Reinstatement of Call Sign WPOZ509

Dear Mr. Roman:

By this letter, we dismiss as moot the petition for reconsideration you filed on behalf of the Municipality of Florida, Puerto Rico (Florida) of the dismissal of the above-referenced renewal application.¹ This letter also dismisses as moot Florida's waiver request to accept the late-filed renewal of expired VHF Call Sign WPOZ509.² The petition and waiver request argue that the license for WPOZ509 should be reinstated because Florida's consultant failed to timely renew and modify the license to comply with the Commission's VHF "narrowbanding" requirements.³ On March 5, 2015, Florida filed an application⁴ for Special Temporary Authority (STA) for the same frequencies authorized to WPOZ509, reflecting narrowband emission and providing Quiet Zone concurrence.⁵ Florida also stated that it intends to file a regular license application to replace expired call sign WPOZ509.⁶ On March 12, 2015, the licensing staff granted Florida's STA request under call sign WQVK727. Accordingly, we conclude that Florida's Petition and the request to accept late-filed renewal for WPOZ509 are moot.

We therefore dismiss, pursuant to Sections 4(i), 303(r), and 405 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 303(r), 405, and Sections 1.106, 1.925 and 1.949 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.106, 1.925 and 1.949, the petition for reconsideration and request for waiver filed by the Municipality of Florida, Puerto Rico, as moot.

These actions are taken under delegated authority pursuant to Sections 0.191 and 0.392 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.191, 0.392.
