Re: Application of Cellular South Licenses, LLC d/b/a C Spire Wireless and Waller Wireless, Inc. for Consent To Assign Lower 700 MHz Licenses (WT Docket No. 15-111)

Dear Mr. Graham:

Cellular South Licenses, LLC d/b/a C Spire Wireless (“C Spire”), and Waller Wireless, Inc. (“Waller”) have filed an application pursuant to section 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, seeking the full assignment of three Lower 700 MHz C Block licenses from Waller to C Spire. For the Commission to complete its review of the application and make the necessary public interest findings under section 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“Act”),<sup>1</sup> we require additional information, documents, and clarification of certain matters discussed in the application and other information provided to the Commission. If necessary, we will follow up with additional requests for information.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 308(b) of the Act,<sup>2</sup> we request that you provide written responses and supporting documentation for each request set forth in the attached General Information Request and, where appropriate, amend the application to reflect such responses. Each response or document should clearly indicate the specific question or request to which it responds, and each page should be marked with a corporate identification and consecutive document control numbers as specified in the attached instructions. We would appreciate receiving your response to each inquiry no later than **June 22, 2015**.

Your responses should be filed with Marlene H. Dortch, Secretary, Federal Communications Commission, in WT Docket No. 15-11. In addition, the *Comment Public Notice*<sup>3</sup> and the *Joint Protective Order*<sup>4</sup> require the submission of multiple copies of all *ex parte* and other filings submitted in this
