**ORDER**

**Adopted: January 27, 1997**

By the Chief, Consumer Protection and Competition Division, Cable Services Bureau:

1. Multimedia Cablevision, Inc. ("Multimedia") filed a petition for revocation of the certification of Yukon, Oklahoma ("Yukon") to regulate rates for basic cable service and associated equipment. Yukon filed an opposition, and Multimedia filed a reply. Subsequently, Multimedia and Yukon filed a joint motion to defer action on Multimedia's petition for revocation in order to resolve a number of rate issues independently. On November 26, 1996, Multimedia filed a request to withdraw its petition for revocation on the grounds that Multimedia and Yukon had resolved their differences. Yukon filed no reply.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED**, that Multimedia Cablevision, Inc.'s petition for revocation of the certification of Yukon, Oklahoma to regulate basic cable service rates and associated equipment is **DISMISSED**.

3. This action is taken pursuant to delegated authority pursuant to Section 0.321 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.321.
