### **Annual Report of 95 License Subsidiary, LLC**

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 25.170, 95 License Subsidiary, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Spectrum Five LLC,<sup>1</sup> submits this annual report with information current as of May 31, 2015.

On August 30, 2011, the Commission granted 95 License's application to launch and operate a geostationary satellite orbit space station in the 17/24 GHz Broadcast-Satellite Service (BSS) ("Reverse Band") at the 95.15° W.L. orbital location.<sup>2</sup>

Pursuant to § 25.170(a), 95 License reports that the licensed space station is not yet in service and that the launch milestone is still in the future.

Pursuant to § 25.170(c), 95 License provides the following report on its construction progress. On August 30, 2012, 95 License submitted to the Commission a confidential copy of the satellite construction contract between its parent, Spectrum Five LLC, and Space Systems/Loral, LLC ("SS/L"). On May 10, 2013, at the request of the International Bureau, 95 License submitted (along with a request for confidential treatment) full copies of all exhibits to that construction contract. On August 30, 2013, 95 License submitted to the Commission the final critical design review ("CDR") package that SS/L provided to Spectrum Five upon



completion of CDR on August 23, 2013, and a document dated August 23, 2013 entitled CDR Minutes/Actions demonstrating that the CDR materials were presented to and approved by Spectrum Five in advance of the August 30, 2013 CDR milestone deadline. On September 2, 2014, 95 License submitted to the Commission a signed statement of Michael Santoro, Chief Financial Officer and Senior Vice President of Finance at SS/L, photographs, and other materials for which confidential treatment has been requested, certifying that construction had commenced in advance of the August 30, 2014 deadline for commencement of construction.
