FCC ANNOUNCES THE SECOND MEETING OF THE COMMUNICATIONS SECURITY, RELIABILITY, AND INTEROPERABILITY COUNCIL SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 21, 2015 AT FCC HEADQUARTERS

By this Public Notice, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission), consistent with the Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA),¹ announces that the FCC's Communications Security, Reliability, and Interoperability Council (CSRIC or Council) will meet **Monday, September 21, 2015, beginning at 1:00 p.m.**, in the Commission Meeting Room at FCC Headquarters, located at 445 12th Street, SW, Room TW-C305, Washington, DC 20554. Notice of this meeting was published in the Federal Register on August 21, 2015.²

The CSRIC is a federal advisory committee that provides recommendations to the Commission regarding best practices and actions the Commission can take to help ensure security, reliability, and interoperability of communications systems and infrastructure.

At the meeting, the Council will hear progress reports from the Steering Committee and each of its working groups on their formation and initial meetings. Members of the general public may attend the meeting. The FCC will attempt to accommodate as many attendees as possible; however, admittance will be limited to seating availability.
