**REPORT AND ORDER**  
(Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: November 30, 1988; Released: January 24, 1989

By the Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division:

1. Pursuant to the request of AJP Investment Co., Inc. (petitioner) the Commission has before it for consideration the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 3 FCC Rcd 4648 (1988), proposing the allotment of Channel 288C to Idaho Falls, Idaho, as that community's fourth FM service. Petitioner filed comments requesting allotment of 288C1 in lieu of 288C, because upon further engineering study it was determined that the antenna height required by a full Class C on this allotment would not be feasible. Petitioner stated its intention to apply for the channel, if allotted. No other comments were received.

2. A staff engineering analysis has determined that the allotment of Channel 288C1 can be made in compliance with the minimum distance separation requirements of the Commission's Rules.<sup>1</sup> In view of the fact that the proposed allotment could provide Idaho Falls with its fourth FM service, we believe the public interest would better be served by allotting Channel 288C1 in lieu of 288C to Idaho Falls.

3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective **March 10, 1989**, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, to read as follows:

City	Channel No.
Idaho Falls, Idaho	241C1, 256C1 277C1, 288C1

4. The window period for filing applications will open on **March 13, 1989**, and close on **April 12, 1989**.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
