Files Report on Meet Point Billing

PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED

In an Order¹ released July 31, 1987, the Federal Communications Commission directed the Ordering and Billing Forum (OBF) of the Liaison Committee Exchange Carriers Standards Association, Inc. to investigate the feasibility of extending Meet Point Billing concepts to Feature Group A (FGA) and Feature Group B (FGB). The OBF established the FGA and FGB Work Group to pursue identification, analysis and resolution of issues and options. On December 8, 1988 OBF filed with the Commission its report on Feature Group A and B Meet Point Billing.

Parties wishing to file comments on the above-referenced matter should do so no later than **February 13, 1989**. Reply comments should be filed no later than **February 28, 1989**.
