REPORT AND ORDER
(Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: November 30, 1988; Released: January 27, 1989

By the Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division:

1. The Commission considers herein the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 3 FCC Rcd 2402 (1988), issued at the request of James G. Kirkpatrick (petitioner), proposing the allotment of Channel 270A to Brandon, Vermont, as that community's first local FM service. Petitioner filed supporting comments reaffirming his interest in the proposal. No other comments were received.

2. Channel 270A can be allotted to Brandon in compliance with the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements.¹ Since the community is located within 320 kilometers (200 miles) of the U.S.-Canadian border, concurrence has been obtained from the Canadian government.

3. We believe the public interest would be served by the allotment of Channel 270A to Brandon, Vermont, as that community's first local FM service. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority found in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective **March 13, 1989**, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, as follows:

Brandon, Vermont	270A

4. The window period for filing applications will open on **March 14, 1989** and close on **April 13, 1989**.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
