REPORT AND ORDER
(Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: January 18, 1989; Released: February 2, 1989

By the Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division:

1. The Commission has before it the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 3 FCC Rcd 4029 (1988), proposing the allotment of FM Channel 263A to Port Gibson, Mississippi, as that community's first FM service. The *Notice* was issued in response to a petition filed by Evan Doss, Jr. (petitioner). Comments were filed by the petitioner restating his interest in the allotment. No other comments were received.

2. Channel 263A can be allotted to Port Gibson, Mississippi, consistent with the minimum distance separation requirements of Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules.¹

3. In view of the fact that Channel 263A can be allotted to Port Gibson to provide the community with its first FM broadcast service, we find the allotment to be in the public interest. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective March 20, 1989, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, to read as follows:

Community	Channel No.
Port Gibson, Mississippi	263A

4. The window period for filing applications will open on March 21, 1989, and close on April 20, 1989.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
