**NETWORK COMMUNICATIONS, INC.
FILES COMMENTS ON INDIVIDUAL
CASE BASIS RATES FOR DS3 SERVICES**

PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED

On December 1, 1988, Network Communications, Inc. (NCI), a fiber optic cable provider, filed comments in CC Docket No. 88-136¹ concerning the use of individual case basis (ICB) rates for high capacity DS3 services. The Common Carrier Bureau seeks comment on NCI's submission, particularly NCI's discussion of the extent of competition for DS3 services. The Bureau also encourages comment on NCI's assertion that the Bureau should require the uniform tariffing of DS3 services.
