**REPORT AND ORDER**  
(Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: January 19, 1989; Released: February 8, 1989

By the Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division:

1. Pursuant to the request of Helen Broadcasters (petitioners), the Commission has before it for consideration the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 3 FCC Rcd 5251 (1988), proposing the allotment of Channel 286A to Helen, Georgia, as that community's first local FM service. Petitioner filed comments reiterating its intention to apply for the channel, if allotted. No other comments were filed.

2. As indicated in the *Notice* Channel 286A can be allotted to Helen, Georgia, in compliance with the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements with a site restriction of 1.5 kilometers (1 mile) east to avoid a short-spacing to Station WQSB-FM, Channel 286C, Albertville, Alabama (BLH-870224KC).<sup>1</sup>

3. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting Channel 286A to Helen, Georgia, since it could provide the community with its first local FM service. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective **March 27, 1989**, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, to read as follows:

4. The window period for filing applications will open on **March 28, 1989**, and close on **April 27, 1989**.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
