ERRATUM

On December 28, 1988, the Chief of the Common Carrier Bureau adopted a Memorandum Opinion and Order in this proceeding, DA 88-2069, released January 13, 1989. Footnote 4 of this order inadvertently omitted that 14 days following the filing of informational amendments, the US West CEI plan will be deemed approved, barring Commission action to the contrary. Accordingly, Footnote 4 is amended by adding the following to the beginning of that footnote:

As in other CEI proceedings, unless we take action to the contrary within 14 days after the latest date on which US West submits the informational amendments required in paras. 55 and 64 *infra*, its CEI Plan shall be deemed approved. *See, e.g.*, The Bell Atlantic Telephone Companies, Offer of Comparably Efficient Interconnection to Providers of Voice Messaging Services, *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, DA 88-1473 (released September 30, 1988), at n. 4.
