I. INTRODUCTION

1. On March 17, 1995, Harron Communications Corp. ("Harron"), the operator of a cable television system serving the New York communities identified above, filed with the Commission an appeal of a rate order adopted by the New York State Commission on Cable Television on February 16, 1995, which was applicable to its service in those communities. The rate order established Harron's rates for basic cable service, equipment, installations and hourly service charges, as allowed by the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992. Harron also filed on March 17, 1995 a motion requesting a stay of the rate order pending our review. The New York State Commission filed no opposition.

2. On May 12, 1995, Harron filed with the Commission a motion to dismiss its earlier-filed appeal and stay. No opposition to the motion has been filed. Therefore, Harron's motion to dismiss its appeal and stay request is granted.

II Ordering Clause

3. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED THAT** Harron's motion to dismiss its appeal and stay request of the rate order issued by the New York Commission **IS GRANTED** and the appeal and stay request **ARE DISMISSED**.

4. This action is taken by the Chief, Cable Services Bureau, pursuant to authority delegated by section 0.321 of the Commission's rules. 47 C.F.R. § 0.321 (1993).
