Order Granting Extension of Time

By the Chief, Accounting and Audits Division:

1. On June 7, 1995, the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., ("NECA") requested an extension of time to file its response to the Commission's Order to Show Cause in the captioned proceeding.¹ In that Order, the Commission ordered NECA to show cause why the Commission should not require NECA to amend its incentive compensation plan to eliminate any incentive based on common line or traffic sensitive pool earnings or that could otherwise induce NECA officers or employees to violate Commission rules. NECA's response is due June 19, 1995. NECA requests that we extend the deadline to August 15, 1995, because it needs additional time to complete the process of revising its incentive compensation plan.

2. We have reviewed NECA's request. Although we do not routinely grant extensions of time,² we believe that granting NECA's request will serve the public interest by allowing NECA to address fully the Commission's concerns before submitting its revised incentive compensation plan.


