FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION

By Public Notice (DA 96-2) (released January 11, 1996), the Managing Director announced procedures for the filing of documents that were due to be filed during the time that the Commission was closed during the budget-related shutdown or due to the weather emergency.
