

impact licensees around the country. Also, we find the argument that additional time is needed for copying and distributing comments to interested parties without merit. The Commission's copy contractor routinely provides copies of documents to interested parties across the country.

4. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the request from the Personal Radio Steering Group, Inc., to extend the deadline for filing reply comments in this proceeding IS DENIED.

5. This action is taken pursuant to the authority provided in Section 1.46 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.46.
