Comment Sought on Requests for IVDS Rule Waivers

The Federal Communications Commission seeks comment on the following two requests for waiver of Section 95.819 of the rules, 47 C.F.R. § 95.819. Section 95.819 states that Interactive Video and Data Service (IVDS) licenses not acquired through competitive bidding may not be assigned or transferred until the five-year construction benchmark (50 percent coverage) has been met.

Interested parties may file comments regarding the requests on or before August 10, 1995. Reply comments are due on or before August 21, 1995.
