Re: *AT&T Mobility LLC (AT&T) v. Iowa Wireless Services LLC (iWireless)*, Proceeding No. 15-259; File No. EB-15-MD-007

Dear Counsel:

On October 21, 2015, AT&T filed a Motion for Interim Relief¹ along with its complaint in this matter. iWireless filed an opposition to the Motion for Interim Relief on November 20, 2015.² On November 30, 2015, AT&T filed a motion for leave to file a reply in support of its Motion for Interim Relief, with the proposed reply attached.³ Today, iWireless filed a motion seeking an extension of time to file an opposition to AT&T's Motion for Leave.⁴ iWireless has failed to show good cause for the requested extension. We therefore deny iWireless's Motion.
