**WARNING OF UNLICENSED OPERATION**

On November 23, 2015, an agent from the Dallas office investigated a complaint of radio frequency interference (RFI), to Addison Airport, affecting the frequency 126.0 MHz in Addison, Texas. The agent used direction finding methods to locate a signal that was emanating from your business located both at 1000 W 15<sup>th</sup> Street and 6513 W Park Blvd in Plano, Texas. The agent found an outdoor LED sign, when in use, generated a spurious signal on 126.0 MHz at 6513 W Park Blvd location. Also, at the 1000 W 15<sup>th</sup> Street, when in use, another LED sign, when in use, generated a spurious signal on 126.0088 MHz. The Commission's records do not show that a license has been issued to you for operation on the frequencies at the two locations in Plano, Texas.

Operation of radio transmitting equipment without a valid FCC authorization or license is a violation of Section 301 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>1</sup> and may subject the responsible parties to substantial monetary forfeitures, *in rem* arrest action against the offending radio equipment, and criminal sanctions including imprisonment.<sup>2</sup> Because unlicensed operation creates a danger of interference to important radio communications services and may subject the operator to severe penalties, this warning emphasizes the importance of complying strictly with these legal requirements.

**UNLICENSED OPERATION OF THIS RADIO STATION MUST NOT RESUME.**

You have ten (10) days from the date of this notice to respond with any evidence that you have authority to operate granted by the FCC. To resolve the issues with respect to your authority to operate this device, and pursuant to Section 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>3</sup> provide an explanation as to what has been done to correct the interference issue and to ensure that it will not recur.

Your response should be sent to the address in the letterhead and reference the listed case and document number. Under the Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. § 552a(e)(3), we are informing you that the Commission's staff will use all relevant material information before it to determine what, if any,
