JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT

Complainant, Comcast of Indianapolis, L.P. (“Comcast”), and Respondent, Duke Energy of Indiana, Inc. (“DEI”), jointly move the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) for dismissal of the complaint filed in the above-captioned matter (the “Complaint”). In support, Comcast and DEI state as follows:

1. Comcast filed the Complaint on November 17, 2015.
2. Comcast and DEI reached a confidential settlement agreement regarding the dispute, which was fully executed on December 22, 2015.
3. Accordingly, Comcast and DEI jointly move for dismissal of the Complaint with prejudice. Dismissal of the Complaint will serve the public interest by eliminating the need for further litigation and the expenditure of the associated time and resources of the parties and the Commission and will promote the private resolution of disputes.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Comcast and DEI jointly request that the Commission dismiss the Complaint with prejudice, and terminate the above-captioned

proceeding.
