PROTESTED TARIFF TRANSMITTALS

ACTIONS TAKEN

Pursuant to authority delegated under Section 0.291 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.291, the Tariff Division of the Common Carrier Bureau has reviewed the petitions to reject and the petitions to suspend and investigate the tariff transmittals listed in this Report.
