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## THE INCENTIVE AUCTION TASK FORCE ANNOUNCES A WORKSHOP ON MAKING AN INITIAL COMMITMENT IN THE BROADCAST INCENTIVE AUCTION

On Friday, March 11, 2016, from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm Eastern Time (ET), the Commission's Incentive Auction Task Force, in conjunction with the Media and Wireless Telecommunications Bureaus, will host a public workshop on the procedures for making an initial commitment in the reverse auction (Auction 1001). The workshop will include a demonstration of the initial commitment bidding system. In addition, Commission staff will present a preview of the reverse auction bidding system for the clock phase of Auction 1001.

The workshop will be held in the Commission Meeting Room at FCC Headquarters in Washington, DC, and is open to the public. All attendees are advised to arrive approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of the workshop to allow time to go through the security process for admission to FCC Headquarters.
