Dear Chairman Wheeler:

On October 26, 2012, Emery Telcom (Emery) filed a petition for a waiver of Federal Communications Commission rules related to revenue reporting “to permit [it] to include within its Base Period Revenues amounts received after March 31, 2012.”¹ According to Emery’s petition, the waiver is necessary to correct a “billing configuration error” that affects the company’s eligibility to participate in the Connect America Fund,² which, according to the FCC, will “expand the benefits of high-speed Internet to millions of consumers in every part of the country.”³

On November 9, 2012, the FCC solicited public comments regarding the waiver.⁴ It is my understanding that there were no comments filed in opposition to Emery’s waiver request.

Since then, Emery has contacted and met with various FCC officials regarding the status of its petition as part of an effort to move the FCC toward a resolution. More than three years later, however, the waiver is still pending. During that time, Emery has submitted multiple filings in support of its petition and visited the FCC to provide additional information. No one at the FCC, including you, has indicated that there are issues with the petition, but the FCC has taken no action.

In light of these facts, I request that you review the status of Emery’s petition and provide a date by which you expect the FCC to act on it. Please contact Fred Ferguson, my Chief of Staff, at (202) 225-7751 with any questions about this request.
