**ORDER**

On May 4, 2016, the Presiding Judge held a Prehearing Conference, pursuant to *Order*, FCC 16M-16 (rel. May 2, 2016). After full discussion on the record, the Presiding Judge denied Lake Broadcasting’s Motion to Reject Exhibits, Halt Depositions, and Require a New Evaluation of Michael Rice or Grant Summary Decision, filed on April 14, 2016.

The Presiding Judge also informed Lake Broadcasting’s counsel, Mr. Jacobs, that the Judge wanted to be informed in writing as to whether Lake Broadcasting would be taking the depositions of Dr. Kimberly Weitzl, the Enforcement Bureau’s expert psychologist, and/or Missouri Parole Officer Tammy Gremminger.

It is also noted that counsel for the Bureau circulated the curriculum vitae of Dr. Weitzl, and counsel for Lake Broadcasting circulated an article appearing in the *Journal of Interpersonal Violence* dated October 2014, entitled “High-Risk Sex Offenders May Not Be High Risk Forever.” No relief was sought with respect to either item, which were intended for informational purposes only.

**Rulings**

Accordingly, Lake Broadcasting’s Motion to Reject Exhibits, Halt Depositions, and Require a New Evaluation of Michael Rice or Grant Summary Decision is DENIED.

Furthermore, Lake Broadcasting shall file a notification on or before **Tuesday, May 24, 2016**, informing the Presiding Judge and the Enforcement Bureau of Lake Broadcasting's intention to depose Dr. Weitz and/or Ms. Gremminger, as well as the places and dates of any depositions.<sup>1</sup>
