ORDER

In *Order*, FCC 16M-23 (rel. July 25, 2016), the Presiding Judge dismissed Avenal Educational Services, Inc. and Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. as parties for failure to meet the Commission's qualification requirements when they applied for construction permits. The parties remaining are William L. Zawila, The Estate of Linda Ware d/b/a Lindsay Broadcasting, and The Estate of H.L. Charles d/b/a Ford City Broadcasting (collectively, "the

Zawila parties”). Mr. Zawila is both an individual party and the attorney for the other two Zawila parties.

At the Status Conference on March 29, 2016, the Presiding Judge stated that he was “considering Mr. Zawila to be in default,” Status Conference Tr. 4:16 (March 29, 2016) (hereinafter, “Tr.”), and made clear that Mr. Zawila was “still part of the case [only] because we need him for purposes of discovery.” Tr. 8:4-6. During the same status conference, Bureau counsel stated that if the Presiding Judge imposed negative findings of fact against the Zawila parties, “the Bureau would be in a position to summarily request a summary decision and to have . . . [the Zawila] parties out of this case.” *See* Tr. 33:12-34:2.

In *Order*, FCC 16M-18 (rel. May 10, 2016), the Presiding Judge entered adverse findings of fact against the Zawila parties. Given that they are the only remaining parties, and that adverse findings of fact have been entered against them, the Bureau is invited to consider filing a motion for summary decision, if deemed appropriate.
