**Subject:** FCC Takes Action to Preserve Reliable 911 Service as Technology Evolves

On November 21, 2014, the FCC released a *Policy Statement and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*. In the *Policy Statement*, the FCC affirms its commitment to ensuring reliable and resilient 911 service and its continuing partnership with state and local authorities. In the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, the FCC seeks comment on specific proposals in four key areas to reverse the trend of large-scale 911 outages.

The dates for comments and reply comments will be announced later after the *Policy Statement and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* is published in the Federal Register.
