In recognition of National Cyber Security Awareness Month, the Federal Communications Commission would like students to illustrate how they think an individual can protect themselves over the Internet. Contestants must illustrate the above theme only, and the theme must be included on the poster. Illustrations should be positive in approach, demonstrating what you interpret as online safety.

Please note the following rules:

- Please use only 12" x 18" inch paper or poster board.
- All designs must be original ideas of students
- All entries must be hand drawn.
- Students should use pencil, crayon, markers, or paint.
- No stenciled, pre-printed, manufactured stick-on, or press on letters may be used
- Wood, plaster, glass or metal should not be a part of the poster. Collage materials should not be used.
- Lamination is not permitted
- Poster design may not incorporate any copyrighted characters (*i.e.* comic and/or television characters, photographs, or magazine/newspaper illustrations).
- Once submitted, all posters become the property of the FCC and will not be returned. FCC reserves the right to reproduce and display the poster to promote the FCC's support of National Cyber Security Awareness Month.
- Only first-, second-, third-place, winners will be notified personally. Winners will be notified by September 24, 2013.
