NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: January 10, 2012

By the District Director, Philadelphia Office, Northeast Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's rules¹ to ComPros, Inc. ("ComPros"), the operator of a radio servicing company and the licensee of Private Land Mobile Station WPGM583.

2. On December 14, 2011, while responding to an interference complaint, agents of the Enforcement Bureau's Philadelphia Office observed unauthorized transmissions from Indiana County Transit Authority ("ICTA") on the frequency 453.825 MHz. According to the FCC database, ICTA is authorized to operate on the frequency 453.850 MHz under call sign WPKP531. ICTA reported that ComPros had programmed its radios. After further investigation, the agent found the following violation:

47 C.F.R. § 90.427(b): "Except for frequencies used in accordance with § 90.417, no person shall program into a transmitter frequencies for which the licensee using the transmitter is not authorized." By programming radio transmitters with a frequency for which ICTA was not authorized, ComPros violated Section 90.427(b) of the Commission's rules.

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's rules, ComPros must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a member of ComPros. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
