Streamlined International Applications Accepted For Filing

Section 214 Applications (47 C.F.R. § 63.18); Section 310(B)(4) Requests

Unless otherwise specified, the following procedures apply to the applications listed below:

The international Section 214 applications listed below have been found, upon initial review, to be acceptable for filing and subject to the streamlined processing procedures set forth in Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.12. These applications are for authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 214, (a) to transfer control of an authorized carrier or to assign a carrier's existing authorization; and/or (b) to become a facilities-based international common carrier; and/or (c) to become a resale-based international common carrier.

Pursuant to Section 63.12 of the rules, these Section 214 applications will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice (see 47 C.F.R. § 1.4 regarding computation of time), and the applicant may commence operations on the 15th day, unless the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days after the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

Communications between outside parties and Commission staff concerning these applications are permitted subject to the Commission's rules for "permit-but-disclose proceedings." See 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206. An application can be removed from streamlined processing only in the sound discretion of Commission staff. The filing of comments or a petition to deny will not necessarily result in an application being deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

The petitions for declaratory ruling listed below are for authority under Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 310(b)(4), to exceed the 25 percent foreign ownership benchmark applicable to common carrier radio licensees. The requested rulings will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice, effective the next day, unless the application is formally opposed or the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days of the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing. For this purpose, a formal opposition shall be sufficient only if it is received by the Commission and by the applicant within 14 days of the date of this public notice and its caption and text make it unmistakably clear that it is intended to be a formal opposition.

Application filed for consent to the transfer of control of international section 24 authorization, ITC-214-20090624-00301, held by Stanacard, LLC (Stanacard), from Michael Choupak (Choupak) to Anastasia Koroleva (Koroleva). Prior to the transaction, Choupak and Koroleva each held a 44.44% membership interest in Stanacard. Choupak held de facto control of Stanacard as its manager. On June 21, 2011, without prior Commission consent, Choupak assigned all of his membership interest in Stanacard to Koroleva and resigned from his position as manager. Upon closing, Koroleva holds control of Stanacard with 88.88% membership interest and was elected the company manager. Eduard Romanov continues to hold the remaining 11.11% membership interest in Stanacard.

Application filed for consent to the transfer of control of international section 214 authorization, ITC-214-20050223-00074, held by Verscom, LLC (Verscom), from Eren Nil to Gokce Bilyay. Prior to the transaction, Eren Nil held a majority 70% ownership interest in Verscom and Gokce Bilyay was one of four minority interest holders each of whom held a 7.5% ownership interest in Verscom. On April 13, 2011, without prior Commission consent, the ownership interests in Verscom were redistributed and Gokce Bilyay now holds a 70% ownership interest and Eren Nil holds a 10% ownership interest in Verscom. In addition, Emir Nil now holds a 20% ownership interest in Verscom. Gokce Bilyay, Eren Nil and Emir Nil are all citizens of Turkey.

Applicant filed a request for Special Temporary Authority (STA) related to this transaction, ITC-STA-20120203-00041, which was granted on February 16, 2012.
